1. Before you proceed further, please ensure that you:
  - a. are aged between 18 and 30 as at **30 Apr 2008**;
  - b. have the minimum of two GCE 'A' Levels and three GCSEs ('O' Levels) or equivalent in five separate subjects, including English and Mathematics (for normal entry);
  - c. are at least 21 year-old (for *Mature Student Entry Route* - MSER);
  - d. have completed the final CAT papers in the Dec 2007 exams (for CAT-ACCA transfer student – if you fall under this category, please contact ACCA Singapore for more details);
  - e. have read and understood the **Terms and Conditions (Section Six)** found on the last page of this document.
2. Please complete the application form providing all requested information. If a section or part is not applicable to you, please indicate as "NA" or "Nil" where appropriate.
3. Enclose supporting documents where appropriate – types of possible attachments are listed in **Section Five**.
4. Please ensure that the declaration and consent section (**Section Four**) is signed and dated.
5. Send the completed form and all the attachments to ACCA Singapore – this must be received by ACCA Singapore on or before **30 April 2008 (Wednesday)**. *Forms received after 30 April 2008 will not be considered.*
6. If you wish to receive an acknowledgement of your application, please provide further details at the lower portion of Page 6 (*Acknowledgement Slip*) and adhere sufficient postage in the postage stamp box.
7. Non-Singaporeans must secure their own student pass or permission from the relevant authorities to pursue a course of studies in Singapore before the start of class.
8. Please note that the decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee is **final** and no correspondence on this matter will be entertained.
9. The following are grounds for immediate disqualification:
  - a. Is a registered ACCA student member before 15 December 2007 (except for CAT transfer students – 1d above)
  - b. Has been suspended from the ACCA register and in the process of re-registering (RR)
  - c. Is currently a recipient of an award, grant, or a scholarship from an institution, school or organisation

## Section Six

### Terms and Conditions

1. Duration of award: The ACCA Scholarship award (**ACCA Nurture**) is for the pursuit of the **ACCA Qualification**, and shall be for the duration of the course of studies or a maximum of 5 years from the date of the award, whichever is shorter.
2. Value of Award: the ACCA Scholarship covers:
  - a. initial registration and annual subscription fees to both ACCA and ICPAS\*
  - b. tuition and revision fees levied by the learning partner(s) (*first attendance only*)
  - c. examination fees (*first attempt only*) and/or exemption fees
  - d. OBU marking and mentorship fee (*first attempt only*)
  - e. a one-time book allowance of S\$250 (for the whole duration of the scholarship)
3. Eligibility to study: Non-Singaporeans must secure their own student pass or permission from the relevant authorities to pursue a course of studies in Singapore. This must be done in time to be registered as an ACCA student by the registration deadline.
4. The recipient may attempt the ACCA exams at a rate that is comfortable for progress, but must complete all 14 papers of the ACCA examinations within the stipulated period of 5 years.
5. The award may be withdrawn under the following situations:
  - a. Breach of Professional Conduct
    - i. Causing disrepute to the reputation and good name of ACCA;
    - ii. Cheating and plagiarism in ACCA exams and project
    - iii. Failure to abide by the Terms and Conditions of this scholarship, the ACCA by-laws, and/or the rules and regulations of the assigned learning provider
  - b. Unsatisfactory academic performance:
    - i. Repeated failure in a paper by more than 3 times
    - ii. Failure to complete programme within 5 years
  - c. Other Reasons:
    - i. For non-Singaporeans, the status as a student is revoked or cancelled by ICA or the relevant authorities
    - ii. Inability of student to continue with the scholarship programme
    - iii. Circumstances beyond the control of the recipient, with confirmation from ACCA Singapore
6. In the event of withdrawal as a result of clause 5(a), ACCA Singapore reserves the right to seek compensation and the recovery of all fees paid with cost from the recipient.
7. The recipient will report to the ACCA Singapore office on a regular basis – generally once a month, but frequency may be increased in relation to performance – subject to the sole discretion of ACCA Singapore.
8. In relation to item 7 above, the recipient will be subject to reviews, updates and reports, with reference to the “*Statements of Commitment*” and the “*Career and Educational Objectives*” (submitted under **Section Three** of this document).
9. On the successful completion of the examinations, the recipient will be known as the *ACCA Scholar*, and will be required to remain as an ACCA affiliate or member for a minimum period of five (5) years from the date of the last examination.
10. The *ACCA Scholar* will be required to perform ambassadorial and representation duties and functions for the purpose of promoting the ACCA Qualification, examinations and membership; and be involved in ACCA events and activities deemed necessary towards this end, as determined by ACCA Singapore, for a period of five (5) years from the date of the last examination.
11. All other fees and charges not explicitly listed are not included in this award.
12. ACCA Singapore reserves the right to amend or change the terms and conditions of this award without prior consultation with the recipient.
